CULT VISION PRESENTS YAIR NEUMANS DESIGNS FROM DELEREX™.

For this year's Clerkenwell Design Week Fringe Festival, Cult Vision Curated Eyewear in Clerkenwell will display DELEREX™ lamps and eyewear by conceptual, product – and eyewear designer Yair Neuman.

Focusing on the theme of vision, Yair's DELEREX™ range includes lights and eyewear frames made entirely from discarded lenses from the eyewear industry.

DELEREX™ is a translucent or coloured material, made entirely from discarded lenses from the eyewear industry. Yair Neuman invented DELEREX™ in direct response to seeing the excess of plastic in the eyewear sector that is usually destined for the incinerator. His invention turns this 'waste' into a new, aesthetically pleasing material.

The collection is intended to be unapologetically highly visible and features chunky DELEREX™ that is polished to a high sheen. This emphasises the stunning qualities of the material, providing 100% expression from 100% recycled plastic.



This will be the third time CULT VISION takes part in the Clerkenwell Design Week Fringe Festival and the CULT VISION founders Marianne and Panos Nicolaou are very excited for the come-back of the show this year.

In 2019, their in-house creative technologists designed a retro claw grabber to be part of an interactive window display: 'Up for Grabs'. Visitors were invited to test their skill at operating the retro claw grabber with design prizes up for grabs: Flat pack bird house by London design studio Smith.Matthias, Lens cloths by Textile Designer Amelia Graham and Leather Eyewear cases by Manu Torres Eyewear.

The previous year, Cult Vision presented bespoke programmable LED eyewear displays for the Fringe Festival. Conceived by CULT VISION founder Panos Nicolaou, designed and built by furniture designer Peter Cathersides and enhanced with built-in tech by Creative Technologist Justin Nowell. These are still part of the Cult Vision furniture today.
